Workshop for "Cross-Boundary Road Transport" on operations, clearance, liability, taxation and freight payment collection









In Hong Kong, cross-boundary road transport plays an important role in import and export. Cross-boundary road transport is always classified as pre-carriage or on-carriage sector of international transport.

Hong Kong itself is not a production place. However, it is a global transshipment hub. Crossboundary road transport serves as a transport means to bring shipments from mainland to overseas through Hong Kong gateway. As from 2022, China has imposed a tight guarantine policy towards cross-boundary road transport and its make cross-boundary road transport face with a difficult time.

Unlike air or sea mode of transport, cross-boundary road transport has not much written materials such as textbook, written theory or know-how. The objective of the workshop to help participants grasp a general understanding of cross-boundary road transport. The workshop will be very practical in nature covering from operations, customs declaration/clearance, legal, liability, taxation as well as invoicing issues.

After completion of the workshop, participant can be confident in communications with customers and handling of their inquiries.

跨境道路運輸研討會 (貨運操作、清關、責任、稅務和運費收取方式)

跨境道路運輸在香港出入口貨運中扮演著重要角色。跨境道路運輸一直被列為國際運輸之前段運輸(pre-carriage)或后段運輸(on-carriage)。

香港本身不是産品生產地,然而她是全球轉運之樞紐中心。跨境道路運輸是將貨物從內地經香港運往海外之運輸方式。從 2022 年起,中國對跨境道路運輸實施嚴格的檢疫政策,使跨境道路運輸面臨重大挑戰。

有別於空運或海運,坊間的跨境道路運輸教學材料不足,如課本、書面理論或相關知識。是次 研討會旨在加深學員對跨境道路運輸的了解,內容非常實用,涵蓋貨運操作、報關/清關、法律、 責任、稅務,以及發票等問題,有助提升學員與客戶溝通和處理查詢的能力。
